





Nursery Home learning

Topic - We Are Builders

<p><u>Investigation</u> This half term we will be looking at 'Materials' This week we are investigating Wood. Can you have a look around your house for things made from wood. Are they all the same? Think about their shape, size and colour. Are they strong? Do they bend. What happens when they get wet? Do they float?</p>	<p><u>The three little pigs</u> I wonder if you can create some puppets to retell the story of the 3 little pigs. You could use the puppets from the activity pack or make some sock puppets, finger puppets, of even masks ... I wonder which character you will be...</p> 	<p><u>Story Time</u> Can you share the traditional tale The Three Little Pigs. You can watch it on You Tube. Can you find other traditional tales to share at home?</p> 	<p><u>House building</u> Can you get creative and make a house? You can paint one, create one from junk modelling, collage one with paper or any arts and craft resources you have around the house. You could even use Lego!</p> 
<p><u>Tool box - chatterbox</u> Create a box of different tools and building things. Maybe real tools such as a measuring tape, spirit level, old plug, light switch, paint brush etc Talk with a grown up about the different tools and building objects. What are they called? Can you name them and talk about their special job or use?</p>	<p><u>Nursery Bug Hotel</u> Over this half term and as part of our building topic we are going to revamp our Bug Hotel... As you know we have made it from pallets and different types of found materials, e.g. straw, twigs, plant pots, garden canes, to attract bugs of all different shapes and sizes. Maybe you could have a go and start a family project to create something in your garden. Perhaps a bug hotel, a butterfly house, a hedgehog house or a bird box. However big or small. I can't wait to see how creative you will be.</p>		<p><u>On your daily walk</u> Have a look at the houses in your street/ road/ avenue. Are they all the same? Do they have the same features? Look closely at their doors, windows, roof, chimney, garage. Do they have a driveway? What else do you notice? How are they the same? How are they different?</p>
