




<u>Investigation</u>	<u>Spring walk</u>	<u>Story Time</u>	<u>House building</u>
<p>This half term we will be looking at "Materials"</p> <p>This week we are investigating Metal.</p> <p>Can you have a look around your house for things made from Metal. Are they all the same? Think about their shape, size and colour.</p> <p>Are they strong? Do they bend? What happens when they get wet? Do they float?</p>	<p>Can you have a walk out and about and spy signs of Spring. What are the signs of spring? Are the days getting longer?</p> <p>Can you find some bulbs growing or trees in bud? Have you spied any baby animals in the fields? Have a good look over the next couple of weeks.</p> <p>Maybe you could use a magnifying glass. Can you do some observational drawings?</p>	<p>Share the traditional tale The Three Little Pigs.</p> <p>You can also watch it on You tube.</p> <p>Can you find other traditional tales to share at home?</p> <p>Have a look at the 3 little pigs cartoon- Silly symphony.</p> 	<p>Can you get creative and make a building? You can paint one, create one from junk modelling, collage one with paper or any arts and craft resources you have around the house.</p> <p>You could even use Lego!</p> 
<p><u>Tool box - chatterbox</u></p> <p>Create a box of different tools and building things.</p> <p>Maybe real tools such as a measuring tape, spirit level, old plug, light switch, paint brush etc</p> <p>Talk with a grown up about the different tools and building objects. What are they called? Can you name them and talk about their special job or use?</p>	<p><u>Nursery Bug Hotel</u></p> <p>Over this half term and as part of our building topic we are going to revamp our Bug Hotel.. As you know we have made it from pallets and different types of found materials, e.g. straw, twigs, plant pots, garden canes, to attract bugs of all different shapes and sizes.</p> <p>Maybe you could have a go and start a family project to create something in your garden. Perhaps a bug hotel, a butterfly house, a hedgehog house or a bird box. However big or small. I can't wait to see how creative you will be.</p>		<p><u>On your daily walk</u></p> <p>Have a look at different buildings. Maybe you could walk past a church, a shop, a post office, school? What happens in that building? Who works there? Can you buy things there? Do they all have the same features, such as roof, window, door?</p>
