



<p><u>Investigation</u></p> <p>This half term we will be looking at “Materials”</p> <p>This week we are investigating Plastic.</p> <p>Can you have a look around your house for things made from plastic. What happens when it gets warm? Can you bend it &amp; twist it? What happens when it gets wet? What objects around your house are made from plastic? Could they be made from anything else?</p>	<p><u>Spring walk</u></p> <p>Have a walk out and about and spy signs of Spring.</p> <p>What are the signs of spring? Are the days getting longer or shorter?</p> <p>Can you find some bulbs growing or trees in bud? Have you spied any baby animals in the fields?</p> <p>Have a good look over the next couple of weeks.</p> <p>Maybe you could use a magnifying glass. Can you do some observational drawings?</p>	<p><u>Story Time</u></p> <p>Can you share the traditional tale ‘The Pig is in the Pond’</p> <p>You can watch it on You Tube.</p> <p>Can you find and read some other stories about pigs or farms?</p> 	<p><u>Water</u></p> <p>Can you investigate water... Where does it come from? Can you find it in puddles, ponds rivers the sea? Visit the beach and splish, splash, splosh in the sea.</p> <p>Can you make water different colours by adding cordial or food colouring? Can you pour it into different containers? What happens? Can you make it warmer and colder?</p>
<p><u>Animal - chatterbox</u></p> <p>Create a box of different animals or objects from a farm - maybe puppets, pictures and small farm animal figures. Talk with a grown up about the different animals (what are the baby animals called e.g. calf, kid). Talk about the objects, what are they called? Can you name them and talk about their special job or use e.g. troughs, hay, tractor, bailer.</p>	<p><u>Nursery Bug Hotel</u></p> <p>Over this half term and as part of our building topic we are going to revamp our Bug Hotel. As you know we have made it from pallets and different types of found materials, e.g. straw, twigs, plant pots, garden canes, to attract bugs of all different shapes and sizes.</p> <p>Maybe you could have a go and start a family project to create something in your garden, a bug hotel, a butterfly house, a hedgehog house or a bird box. However big or small. I can't wait to see how creative you will be.</p>		<p><u>On your daily walk</u></p> <p>Have a look at different signs. Maybe they are street signs, road work signs or traffic signs. What information are they telling us? How do they keep us safe? Can you make some signs to put around your house? E.g. No shoes here / No wolves / Warning – hot food</p>
