


<p><u>Investigation</u> <u>Number of the week</u> The number this week is 4. E.g. Mrs Evans has found... A number 4 on a number plate, 4 birds in the garden, 4 biscuits in the tin ? What can you find? As your child counts the objects encourage them to touch them and say the number out loud. Maybe you could draw the number in the sand with a stick. Look for the numeral, maybe on a Birthday card or a road sign.</p>	<p><u>Spring walk</u> Can you have a walk out and about and spy signs of Spring.. What are the signs of spring? Are the days getting longer. Can you find some bulbs growing or trees in bud? Have you spied any baby animals in the fields? Have a good look over the next couple of weeks. Maybe you could use a magnifying glass. Can you do some observational drawings ?</p>	<p><u>Story Time</u> Can you share the Traditional tale Jack and the Beanstalk Can you find an alternative version to read. Maybe you could devise your own ending.. What other traditional tales can you read ?</p> 	<p><u>Garden</u> Have a look in the garden or park for different plants or flowers. Which ones are tall? Which ones are short? Which are the tallest, shortest... Can you make a repeating pattern Petal/leaf/petal/leaf/petal Leaf /stick/ leaf/ stick Tall, short, tall short</p>
<p><u>Growing - chatterbox</u> Can you create a box of different objects connected with Gardening and growing.. Maybe you will pop in some garden tools, seeds, magazines. Plant pots etc. Talk about the different objects</p>	<p><u>Planting</u> Can you plant a bean, seed or pea in a small pot ? What will the plant/ seed need to grow,(soil, sunshine, water) how will you look after it Maybe you could make a little bean diary... I wonder what would happen to the bean if it had no water, no soil, no light.?</p>	<p><u>In the supermarket/ Shops</u> Have a look at different types of beans.. How many different types can you find? Are they fresh, frozen, dried or in tins ? Green, French, butter, baked, mung, broad...</p>
