Reception Weekly News

Thank you for all the wonderful baby photos you have sent in this week. We had a wonderful time playing Guess who... trying to work out who is who. This week we have finished the Gingerbread Man story and finally discovered the fate of the Gingerbread man. In our maths, we have been subitising, this is when we can spot an amount without counting it using our fast eye. We have worked really hard at this and are very good at recognising amounts up to 3 now.

This week we have met Mrs Boardman and found out all about what happens in the Rainbow Room. We talked about first aid for your feelings and had a little visit to see where it is.

In our phonics sessions this week, we have learnt the sound **(phoneme)** d. So far we have learnt the sounds **s.a.t.p.i.n.m.d.** Please practise recognising these sounds at home. They may seem easy to us but these graphemes (how the sound is written down) are very new for the children and can be quite tricky to remember at home. As discussed in the phonics workshop, just like anything practise makes perfect! Thank you to all the parents who are helping with this at home.

The **Book Swap Shed** is now just outside the Reception playground near the bike store. Please do bring and take books to swap. We are loving seeing it being used!

Drop off and collection

Drop off- please note that we will be promptly shutting our gates at 8:50am.

Please could you remind all adults collecting, including Grandparents, after school clubs etc. that if they need to speak to the Reception staff, that they wait until **ALL** children have been safely dismissed, not just your child's class. Weekly Home Learning Challenges

Please can you pracitse reading these words with your child. Write them on some paper to make it easier. You could even write two of each word and make a pairs game but you can only keep them if you can read them! Remind your child to sound out each sound and squeeze them (blend) them together. You could even have a go at writing some too. Ask your child to stretch the word apart and then chop it up (segment) and write the sounds they can hear. **Practising regularly will really support your child!**
