
#### Reading Golden Ticket

Congratulations to all of the children in Year 1 & Year 2 who have achieved their reading target for this half term and have this week received their Gold Ticket reward. Nearly all of the children in Year 1 managed to read at least 24 times this half term and an amazing 100% of Year 2 children managed to read 30 times this half term. Well done all.

Congratulations to classes 4, 7,8 and 9, who have managed 100% of children to achieve their Golden Ticket target this half term. If you have not managed to achieve the target this half term, you can try again next half term. If you are finding reading with your children at home tricky, please speak to your child's class teacher or Miss Oldham our school English Lead and we can work together to develop a strategy.

After half term Reception will also be taking part in Golden Ticket Reward and will have the target of 21 reads before the end of the term (Dec 23) to achieve their Golden Ticket Reward. Reception children will have received reading diaries and log in details, along with a quide of how to do this and complete the diary this week.





#### Reception & Nursery Intake September 2024
